

This easy and colorful craft helps kids remember that Jesus is their light no matter where they go!

What you need:

- Clear plastic cup
- Battery tea lights
- Tissue paper squares (pre-cut)
- Glue stick
- Markers (optional)
- Stickers (optional)



What you do:

- 1. Use the glue stick to press colorful tissue paper squares around the outside of the cup.
- 2. Add a simple phrase like "Jesus is my Light" or use fun stickers to decorate.
- 3. Turn on the tea light and place it inside the cup.
- 4. Turn off the lights and let your lantern glow!
